This whole set is made of reading assignments.

- 1. First, read §6.2.a—b of the *Superspace* book (local online copy) about the gauge fixing and the ghosts in supersymmetric Yang–Mills theories.
  - §6.2.a is a warm-up exercise, it discusses the gauge fixing and the ghosts in the ordinary Yang–Mills but it sets up the notations and the framework for discussing the superfield discussion in §6.2.b.
- 2. Second, read the 1982 paper by Edward Witten, Constraints On Supersymmetry Breaking, (published in Nuclear Physics B 202 (1982), pages 252–316, local online copy) about the Witten index and other constraints on spontaneous SUSY breaking (perturbative or nonperturbative).

This is a long and hard paper, so please read carefully. Try to go through the first half of the paper (sections 1 through 6) this week, you can read the rest of the paper next week. Also, at first reading, skim through section 3 and focus on the more important sections 1–2 and 4–6. Once you understand those section, go back to section 3.
